

**Displaying Images**

Regardless of the print size specified for an image, the size of an image on-screen is determined by the pixel dimensions of the image and the monitor size and setting. A large monitor set to 640 x 480 pixels uses larger pixels than a small monitor with the same setting. In most cases, default Macintosh monitor settings are designed to display approximately 72 pixels per inch; default PC monitor settings typically display 96 pixels per inch.

Image size: 640 x 480 pixels,  
Print size: 288 ppi (2.22" x 1.67")
